Page 127

John 14:24 “He who does not love Me does not guard My Words. And the Word which you hear is not Mine but of the Father Who sent Me.

John 3:34 “For He whom Elohim has sent speaks the Words of Elohim, for Elohim does not give the Spirit by measure.

John 7:16 יהושע answered them and said, “My teaching is not Mine, but His who sent Me.¹ Footnote: 1Deut. 18:15-20.

John 8:28 So יהושע said to them, “When you lift up the Son of Adam, then you shall know that I am He, and that I do none at all of Myself, but as My Father taught Me, these words I speak.

John 8:40 “But now you seek to kill Me, a Man who has spoken to you the truth which I heard from Elohim. Abraham did not do this.

John 12:49 “Because I spoke not from Myself, but the Father who sent Me has given Me a command,¹ what I should say and what I should speak.
Footnote: 1See 7:16.

John 17:8 “Because the Words which You gave to Me, I have given to them. And they have received them, and have truly known that I came forth from You, and they believed that You sent Me.

Deut 18:18 ‘I shall raise up for them a Prophet like you out of the midst of their brothers. And I shall put My Words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him.

Deut 18:19 ‘And it shall be, the man who does not listen to My Words which He speaks in My Name, I require it of him.

Deut 18:20 'But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in My Name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other mighty ones, even that prophet shall die.'

John 15:7 "If you stay in Me, and My Words stay in you, you shall ask whatever you wish, and it shall be done for you.

John 8:31 So יהושע said to those Yehudim who believed Him, "If you stay in My Word, you are truly My taught ones,

Deut 4:13 "And He made known to you His covenant which He commanded you to do, the Ten Words, and He wrote them on two tablets of stone.

Acts 7:38 "This is he who was in the assembly in the wilderness with the Messenger who spoke to him on Mount Sinai, and with our fathers, who received the living Words to give to us,

John 14:24 He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me. (KJV)

Philippians 2:13 for it is Elohim who is working in you¹ both to desire and to work for His good pleasure. Footnote: ¹See Messiah in you in the Explanatory Notes.

Hebrews 13:20 And the Elohim of peace who brought up our Master יהושע from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,

Hebrews 13:21 make you perfect¹ in every good work to do His desire, working in you² what is pleasing in His sight, through יהושע Messiah, to whom be esteem forever and ever. Amĕn.

Matt 5:6 "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness,¹ because they shall be filled. Footnote: ¹Isa. 55:1-2, Mt. 4:4, John 6:48-51.

Matt 5:9 "Blessed are the peacemakers, because they shall be called sons of Elohim.

Mark 7:7 And in vain do they worship Me, teaching as teachings the commands of men.’¹ Footnote: ¹See Isa. 29:13, 2 Ki. 17:19, and Mt. 15:3-9.

Mark 7:8 “Forsaking the command of Elohim, you hold fast the tradition of men.”

Mark 7:9 And He said to them, “Well do you set aside the command of Elohim, in order to guard your tradition.

Mark 7:10 “For Mosheh said, ‘Respect your father and your mother,’ and, ‘He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.’

Mark 7:11 “But you say, ‘If a man says to his father or mother, “Whatever profit you might have received from me, is Qorban (that is, a gift),” ’

Mark 7:12 you no longer let him do any matter at all for his father or his mother,

Mark 7:13 nullifying the Word of Elohim through your tradition which you have handed down. And many such traditions you do.”

Colossians 2:8 See to it that no one makes a prey of you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the elementary matters of the world,¹ and not according to Messiah.

Footnote: ¹See v. 20, and Gal. 4:3 & 9.

Acts 17:16 But while Sha’ul was waiting for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred up within him when he saw that the city was utterly idolatrous.

Acts 17:17 Therefore, indeed, he was reasoning in the congregation with the Yehudim and with the gentile worshippers, and in the market-place daily with those who met there.

Acts 17:18 And some of the Epicurean and Stoic philosophers encountered him. And some were saying, “What does this babbler wish to say?” Others said, “He seems to be a proclaimer of strange mighty ones” – because to them he brought the Good News: יהושע and the resurrection!

Acts 17:19 So they laid hold of him and brought him to the Areopagus, saying, “Are we able to know what this fresh teaching is of which you speak?

Acts 17:20 “For you are bringing some strange matters to our ears. We wish, then, to know what these mean.”

Acts 17:21 For all the Athenians and the strangers living there spent their leisure time in doing naught but to speak or to hear what is fresh.

Paul Addresses the Areopagus

Acts 17:22 And having stood in the midst of the Areopagus Sha'ul said, "Men of Athens, I see that you are very religious in every matter.

Acts 17:23 "For passing through and observing the objects of your worship, I even found an altar with this inscription: TO THE UNKNOWN MIGHTY ONE. Not knowing then whom you worship, I make Him known to you:

Acts 17:24 "יהוה, who made the world and all that is in it, this One being Master of heaven and earth, does not dwell in dwellings made with hands.¹ Footnote: ¹See 7:48.

Acts 17:25 "Nor is He served with men's hands – as if needing any – Himself giving to all life, and breath, and all else.

Acts 17:26 "And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, having ordained beforehand the times and the boundaries of their dwelling,

Acts 17:27 to seek the Master, if at least they would reach out for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us.

Acts 17:28 "For in Him we live and move and are, as also some of your own poets have said, 'For we are also His offspring.'

Acts 17:29 "Now then, since we are the offspring of Elohim, we should not think that the Elohim is like gold or silver or stone, an image made by the skill and thought of man.

Acts 17:30 "Truly, then, having overlooked these times of ignorance, Elohim now commands all men everywhere to repent,

Acts 17:31 because He has set a day on which He is going to judge the world in righteousness by a Man whom He has appointed,¹ having given proof of this to all by raising Him from the dead." Footnote: ¹See 10:42.

Acts 17:32 And hearing of the resurrection of the dead, some indeed mocked, while others said, "We shall hear you again concerning this."

Acts 17:33 And so Sha'ul went out from among them.

Acts 17:34 But some men joined him and believed, among them Dionusios the Areopagite, and a woman named Damaris, and others with them.

Acts 17:30 “Truly, then, having overlooked these times of ignorance, Elohim now commands all men everywhere to repent,
 Acts 17:31 because He has set a day on which He is going to judge the world in righteousness by a Man whom He has appointed,¹ having given proof of this to all by raising Him from the dead.” Footnote: ¹See 10:42.

Titus 2:14 who gave Himself for us, to redeem us from all lawlessness¹ and to cleanse for Himself a people, His own possession, ardent for good works.² Footnotes: ¹Lawlessness is a synonym for sin (1 John 3:4), Mt. 1:21, Acts 3:19 & 26, Acts 26:18, Rom. 6:1-22, Eph. 2:1-10, 1 John 3:8, Titus 3:5. ²Mt. 16:27.

Genesis 15:6 And he believed in יהוה, and He reckoned it to him for righteousness.

Genesis 26:5 because Abraham obeyed My voice and guarded My Charge: My commands, My laws, and My Torot¹.” Footnote: ¹Torot - plural of Torah, teaching

Ephesians 2:8 For by favour you have been saved, through belief, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of Elohim,

Ephesians 2:9 it is not by works, so that no one should boast.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Messiah יהושע unto good works, which Elohim prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Titus 2:14 who gave Himself for us, to redeem us from all lawlessness and to cleanse for Himself a people, His own possession, ardent for good works.

James 2:14 My brothers, what use is it for anyone to say he has belief but does not have works? This belief is unable to save him.

James 2:15 And if a brother or sister is naked and in need of daily food,

James 2:16 but one of you says to them, “Go in peace, be warmed and be filled,” but you do not give them the bodily needs, what use is it?

James 2:17 So also belief, if it does not have works, is in itself dead.

James 2:18 But someone might say, “You have belief, and I have works.” Show me your belief without your works, and I shall show you my belief by my works.

James 2:19 You believe that Elohim is one. You do well. The demons also believe – and shudder!

James 2:20 But do you wish to know, O foolish man, that the belief without the works is dead?

James 2:21 Was not Abraham our father declared right by works when he offered Yitshaq his son on the altar?

James 2:22 Do you see that the belief was working with his works, and by the works the belief was perfected?

James 2:23 And the Scripture was filled which says, “Abraham believed Elohim, and it was reckoned to him for righteousness.” And he was called, “Elohim’s friend.”

James 2:24 You see, then, that a man is declared right by works, and not by belief alone.

John 5:14 Afterward יהושע found him in the Set-apart Place, and said to him, “See, you have been made well. Sin no more, so that no worse matter befalls you.”

John 8:11 And she said, “No one, Master.” And יהושע said to her, “Neither do I condemn you. Go and sin no more.”

Rev 12:17 And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to fight with the remnant of her seed, those guarding the commands of Elohim and possessing the witness of יהושע Messiah.

Rev 14:12 Here is the endurance of the set-apart ones, here are those guarding the commands of Elohim and the belief of יהושע.

Matthew 23:8 “But you, do not be called ‘Rabbi,’ for One is your Teacher, the Messiah, and you are all brothers.

Matthew 23:10 “Neither be called leaders, for One is your Leader, the Messiah.

Isaiah 30:20 Though יהוה gave you bread of adversity and water of affliction, your Teacher¹ shall no longer be hidden. But your eyes shall see your Teacher¹, Footnote: ¹Or teachers. See also Joel 2:23.

Isaiah 30:21 and your ears hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the Way, walk in it," whenever you turn to the right, or whenever you turn to the left.

Titus 2:13 looking for the blessed expectation and esteemed appearance of the great Elohim and our Saviour יהושע Messiah,
Titus 2:14 who gave Himself for us, to redeem us from all lawlessness and to cleanse for Himself a people, His own possession, ardent for good works.

John 3:36 He who believes in the Son has eternal life; he who does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God rests upon him. (RSV)

Matthew 13:11 And he answered them, "To you it has been given to know the secrets of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it has not been given.

Matthew 13:12 For to him who has will more be given, and he will have abundance; but from him who has not, even what he has will be taken away.

Matthew 13:13 This is why I speak to them in parables, because seeing they do not see, and hearing they do not hear, nor do they understand.

Matthew 13:14 With them indeed is fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah which says: 'You shall indeed hear but never understand, and you shall indeed see but never perceive.

Matthew 13:15 For this people's heart has grown dull, and their ears are heavy of hearing, and their eyes they have closed, lest they should perceive with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and turn for me to heal them.'

John 8:31 Jesus then said to the Jews who had believed in him, "If you continue in my word, you are truly my disciples,

John 8:32 and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."

John 8:33 They answered him, "We are descendants of Abraham, and have never been in bondage to any one. How is it that you say, 'You will be made free'?"

John 8:34 Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, every one who commits sin is a slave to sin.

John 8:35 The slave does not continue in the house for ever; the son continues for ever.

John 8:36 So if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed.

John 8:51 Truly, truly, I say to you, if any one keeps my word, he will never see death."

John 17:6 "I have manifested thy name to the men whom thou gavest me out of the world; thine they were, and thou gavest them to me, and they have kept thy word.

Rev 14:4 It is these who have not defiled themselves with women, for they are chaste; it is these who follow the Lamb wherever he goes; these have been redeemed from mankind as first fruits for God and the Lamb,

2John 1:9 Any one who goes ahead and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God; he who abides in the doctrine has both the Father and the Son.

Matthew 7:24 "Every one then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house upon the rock;

Matthew 7:25 and the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat upon that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock.

Matthew 7:26 And every one who hears these words of mine and does not do them will be like a foolish man who built his house upon the sand;

Matthew 7:27 and the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell; and great was the fall of it."

Luke 6:46 “But why do you call Me ‘Master, Master,’ and do not do what I say?”

Exodus 32:5 And Aharon saw and built an altar before it. And Aharon called out and said, “Tomorrow is a festival to יהוה.”

Ezekiel 8:9 And He said to me, “Go in, and see the evil abominations¹ which they are doing there.” Footnote: ¹See 6:4, Dt. 4:19, Dt. 17:3, 2 Ki. 23:4-11, 2 Chr. 14:5, Job 31:29, Jer. 19:13, Jer. 44:17, Acts 7:42.

Ezekiel 8:10 And I went in and looked and saw all kinds of creeping creatures, abominable beasts, and all the idols of the house of Yisra’ël, carved all around on the walls.

Ezekiel 8:11 And facing them stood seventy men of the elders of the house of Yisra’ël, and in their midst stood Ya’azanyahu son of Shaphan. Each one had a censer in his hand, and a thick cloud of incense went up.

Ezekiel 8:12 And He said to me, “Son of man, have you seen what the elders of the house of Yisra’ël are doing in the dark, each one in the room of his idols? For they say, ‘יהוה does not see us, יהוה has forsaken the land.’ ”

Ezekiel 8:13 And He said to me, “You are to see still greater abominations which they are doing.”

Ezekiel 8:14 And He brought me to the door of the north gate of the House of יהוה, and I saw women sitting there, weeping for Tammuz.

Ezekiel 8:15 Then He said to me, “Have you seen this, O son of man? You are to see still greater abominations than these.”

Ezekiel 8:16 And He brought me into the inner court of the House of יהוה. And there, at the door of the Hēkal of יהוה, between the porch and the altar, were about twenty-five men with their backs toward the Hēkal of יהוה and their faces toward the east, and they were bowing themselves eastward to the sun.

John 8:31 So יהושע said to those Yehudim who believed Him, “If you stay in My Word, you are truly My taught ones,
 John 8:32 and you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.”
 John 8:33 They answered Him, “We are the seed of Abraham, and have been servants to no one at any time. How do you say, ‘You shall become free’?”
 John 8:34 יהושע answered them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone doing sin is a servant of sin.
 John 14:6 יהושע said to him, “I am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

John 18:37 Then Pilate said to Him, “You are a sovereign, then?” יהושע answered, “You say it, because I am a sovereign. For this I was born, and for this I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice.”

John 17:17 “Set them apart in Your truth – Your Word is truth.
 John 17:17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. (KJV)

Hosea 5:15 “I shall go, I shall return to My place, until they confess their guilt and seek My face, in their distress diligently search for Me, and say,

Hosea 6:1 ‘Come, and let us turn back to יהוה. For He has torn but He does heal us, He has stricken but He binds us up.

Zechariah 1:3 “And you shall say to them, ‘Thus said יהוה of hosts, “Turn back to Me,” declares יהוה of hosts, “and I shall turn back to you,” declares יהוה of hosts.

Zechariah 1:4 “Do not be like your fathers, to whom the former prophets proclaimed, saying, ‘Thus said יהוה of hosts, “Turn back now from your evil ways and your evil deeds.”’ But they did not obey or give heed to Me,” declares יהוה.

Malachi 4:5 “See, I am sending you Ĕliyahu¹ the prophet before the coming of the great and awesome day of יהוה. Footnote: 1Lk. 1:17.

1Kings 18:21 And Eliyahu came to all the people, and said, “How long would you keep hopping between two opinions? If יהוה is Elohim, follow Him; and if Ba'al, follow him.” But the people answered him not a word.

Hebrews 13:20 Now may the God of peace who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great shepherd of the sheep, by the blood of the eternal covenant, (RSV)

Hebrews 13:20 Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, even Jesus our Lord, (NASB)

Hebrews 13:20 May the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, (NIV)

Hebrews 13:20 And the Elohim of peace who brought up our Master יהושע from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, (Scriptures 1998)

Hebrews 10:29 How much worse punishment do you think shall he deserve who has trampled the Son of Elohim underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was set apart as common, and insulted the Spirit of favour?

Exodus 31:16 ‘And the children of Yisra’el shall guard the Sabbath, to observe the Sabbath throughout their generations as an everlasting covenant.

Exodus 31:17 ‘Between Me and the children of Yisra’el it is a sign forever. For in six days יהוה made the heavens and the earth, and on the seventh day He rested and was refreshed.’ ”

Isaiah 24:5 For the earth has been defiled under its inhabitants, because they have transgressed the Torot¹, changed² the law, broken the

everlasting covenant³. Footnotes: ¹Torot - plural of Torah, teaching. ²Jer. 23:36. ³This is the only reason, according to all Scriptures, why the earth shall be burned in the day of judgment – see also 13:9, 13:11, 26:21, 66:24, Mic. 5:15, Zeph. 1:2-18.

Acts 2:37 And having heard this, they were pierced to the heart, and said to Kěpha and the rest of the emissaries, “Men, brothers, what shall we do?”

Acts 2:38 And Kěpha said to them, “Repent, and let each one of you be immersed in the Name of יהושע Messiah for the forgiveness of sins.¹ And you shall receive the gift of the Set-apart Spirit. Footnote: ¹See 2:40, 3:19, 3:26.

Acts 2:39 “For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are far off, as many as יהוה our Elohim shall call.”

Acts 2:40 And with many other words he earnestly witnessed and urged them, saying, “Be saved from this crooked generation.”¹ Footnote: ¹Jer. 51:6, Phil. 2:15, Rev. 18:4.
